## Search of water city

EXCITED researchers believe they have found the remains of churches in a city lost underwater.

They set sail this week to unlock the secrets of Dunwich, swallowed by the sea 500 years ago.

The team is using the latest equipment to identify buildings off Suffolk.

Professor David Sear, of Southampton University said: "It is going well. There is a lot of debris there."

Dunwich fell victim to storm surges in the Tudor period. It was as big as London at the time.
